David Chung seconded the motion and was approved unanimously.

There was no one from the public to comment on this item.

The applicant submitted seven (7) applications for Greater Downtown Special Private Art Permits for the 2019 Old Town Parker Wine Walks with supporting documentation and fees.

Dennis Houston with the Parker Chamber of Commerce was present to describe the 2019 events to the Authority. He stated there will be 21 businesses participating. Volunteers will be used at the ticketing desk who will provide participants wristbands to show age compliance and the

pour count the participant has available. Businesses will be instructed to provide a one-ounce pour. There will be sidewalk controls in place. There will be several off-duty police officers and a security company hired to provide security.

David Chung moved to approve the applications for the Greater Downtown Special Private Art Permits for the Parker Chamber of Commerce Wine Walks on May 17, June 28, July 26, August 23, September 27, and October 25, and December 6, 2019, with the condition that the Certificate of Liability Insurance showing coverage for the June through December dates be submitted to the Town Clerk on or before June 1, 2019.

OTHER BUSINESS

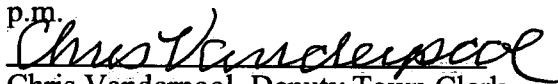
