

**SPECIAL LICENSING AUTHORITY
MINUTES
JUNE 20, 2019**

Chair Chung called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Authority members present were Mike Appleby and Steve Connor. Kelli Narde was absent. Alternate Members Jon Brusco and Bryan Campbell were absent. Staff in attendance were: Town Clerk Carol Baumgartner, Deputy Town Clerk Chris Vanderpool, and Acting Authority Attorney Christy Ausmus.

Chair Chung led the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mike Appleby moved to approve the May 16, 2019 minutes. Steve Conner seconded the motion and was approved unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

A. SPECIAL EVENTS PERMIT APPLICATION (FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGE)

Applicant:	Cherry Creek Valley Rotary Club of Parker
Event:	Brewfest
Location:	O'Brien Park - 10795 Victorian Drive
Date:	August 17, 2019

No one from the public was present to comment.

The applicant submitted a Special Events Permit Application on May 8, 2019, with supporting documents and fees. The applicant had a Notice of Public Hearing posted on this matter on June 10, 2019, ten (10) days prior to the hearing, as required by law.

Eric Dyer, President of the Cherry Creek Valley Rotary Club spoke about the event. He described the layout of the event, how tickets are purchased, how participants will be checked for age compliance by the use of color-coded wristbands. He stated they are expecting 1,400 people. He stated the money raised will go to various charities in Parker. Security will be provided by the Parker Police Department. Volunteers will be stationed at the exits to ensure that no beer leaves the premises.

Steve Conner moved to approve the Special Events Permit Application (Fermented Malt Beverage) for the Cherry Creek Valley Rotary Club of Parker Brewfest event on August 17, 2019, at O'Brien Park, 10795 Victorian Drive.

Mike Appleby seconded the motion and was approved unanimously.

Date: September 13-15, 2019

No one from the public was present to comment.

The applicant submitted a Special Events Permit Application on May 1, 2019, with supporting documents and fees. The applicant had a Notice of Public Hearing posted on this matter on May 10, 2019, ten (10) days prior to the hearing, as required by law.

Meghan Gutteron, Event Manager, spoke and described the event to the Authority. She noted the same set up and standards from last year's event would be used again this year. Identification will be required to show age compliance upon checking in at the registration table. A wristband will be provided. The servers will be trained by the beer provider to ensure there are no issues with over-serving of guests. Parker Police Department will be handling the security. They will also be onsite after hours as there will be equipment on site.

Mike Appleby moved to approve the Special Events Permit Application (Malt, Vinous and Spirituous) for the Council of Arts, Science and Culture, d/b/a Parker Arts Council Oktoberfest event from September 13-15, 2019, at O'Brien Park, 10795 Victorian Drive.

Steve Conner seconded the motion and was approved unanimously.

C. SPECIAL EVENTS PERMIT APPLICATION (MALT, VINOUS AND SPIRITUOUS LIQUOR)

Location: Salisbury Park - 11920 N. Motsenbocker Road
Date: September 7, 2019

No one from the public was present to comment.

The applicant submitted a Special Events Permit Application on May 1, 2019, with supporting documents and fees. The applicant had a Notice of Public Hearing posted on this matter on May 10, 2019, ten (10) days prior to the hearing, as required by law.

Lindsey Phelan, representative for the American Diabetes Association described the event to the Authority. She noted the event is the same as last year. The noted fenced area will be smaller this year. Parker Police Department will provide security for the event. She added there will be a check-in tent where identification will be required to show age compliance. She also stated there will be other activities going on in the park as well. They are expecting 1,200 people this year. Servers will be trained for alcohol awareness. The alcohol will be donated.

She also said that insurance still needed to be provided and would get the certificate to the Town Clerk very soon.

Steve Conner moved to approve the Special Events Permit Application (Malt, Vinous and Spirituous) for the American Diabetes Association, Tour de Cure event on September 7, 2019, at Salisbury Parker, 11920 N. Motsenbocker Road, on the condition that proof of liquor liability insurance be filed with the Town Clerk on or before July 8, 2019.

Mike Appleby seconded the motion and was approved unanimously.

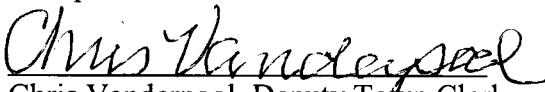
Steve Conner seconded the motion and was approved unanimously.
