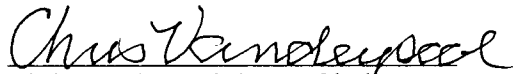

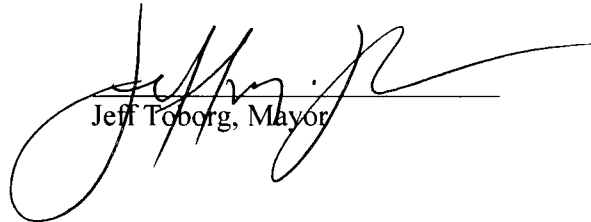
Joshua Rivero moved and Todd Hendreks seconded to come out of Executive Session at 8:02 p.m.
