SUBJECT: Project Update: E-470 Regional Trail

ISSUE:

Review and update Town Council regarding the E-470 Regional Trail project and request input and comments as necessary. Provide status update of The Partners Group (*Arapahoe & Douglas Counties, City of Aurora and Town of Parker*) work efforts to date.

FISCAL/BUDGET IMPACT:

Final costs (*including hard and soft costs*) for the grade-separated overcrossing, east and west trail transitions, plus long-term maintenance of the trail and bridge, will be determined as specific engineering and maintenance cost estimates are prepared and refined. All shared costs and individual jurisdictional responsibilities will ultimately be memorized in the IGA between the jurisdictions represented through The Partners Group. The E-470 Authority has previously contributed approximately \$450,000 towards construction of this regional trail as part of the prior approved IGA between the Town and the Authority.

BACKGROUND:

As part of staff's update on this project we'll be providing a PowerPoint presentation at the May 29 Study Session that includes 3-D renderings of the proposed bridge overcrossing of Parker Road. We will also briefly discuss the following future tasks.

Completion of IGA between Arapahoe/Douglas Counties, Aurora and Parker. This IGA will be phased to address, design, engineering, funding, construction & maintenance.

Complete design, engineering, and cost estimate for overcrossing.

Complete design, engineering, and cost estimates for eastern and western trail transitions within Kings Point development.

Jurisdictions allocation of funding amounts in their 2019 budgets.

Preparation of GOCO grant application in 2019.

GOCO grant application if approved, monies will be available in 2020.

Tentative construction start in 2020 with completion in 2021.

RECOMMENDATION:

Recommend that staff continue to work with The Partners Group to address and resolve issues as needed and provide Town Council regular updates throughout the duration of the project.

REQUESTED DIRECTION:

Direct staff to continue to work with The Partners Group to advance the design, engineering, funding, construction and long-term maintenance of E-470 Regional Trail including the grade separated crossing of Parker Road.
