The staff talked about how the volunteer posters will be given the next meeting, where they will be posted around each school.

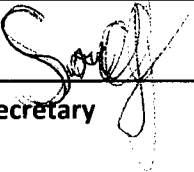
Housekeeping

There is a **Douglas County Voter Center Field Trip at 4:00 on December 16th** for all commission members.

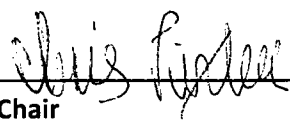
Adjourn- The meeting was adjourned at 8:24 pm. Amara motioned. Landon seconded.
