The Commissioners voted on 5 of the logo designs. The commissioners chose #5 as the first choice and #1 as second if necessary.

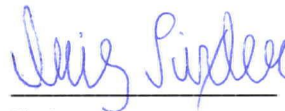
New Event

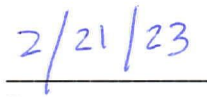

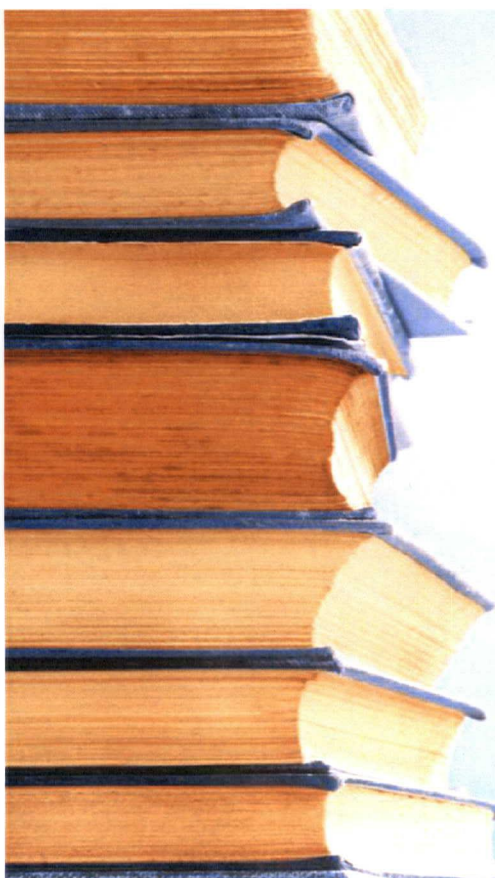
Adjourn- The meeting was adjourned at 8:24 pm. Amara motioned. Noor seconded. The vote was 7-0.

What is curfew and where did it come from?

- Curfew is a regulation requiring people to remain indoors between specified hours, typically at night.
- Curfew ordinances were originally enacted in the 1890's to decrease crime among immigrant youth.
- During World War II, curfews were perceived as an effective control for parents who were busy helping with the war effort.
- More recent interest in juvenile curfew ordinances came as a response to growing juvenile crime during the 1970's.

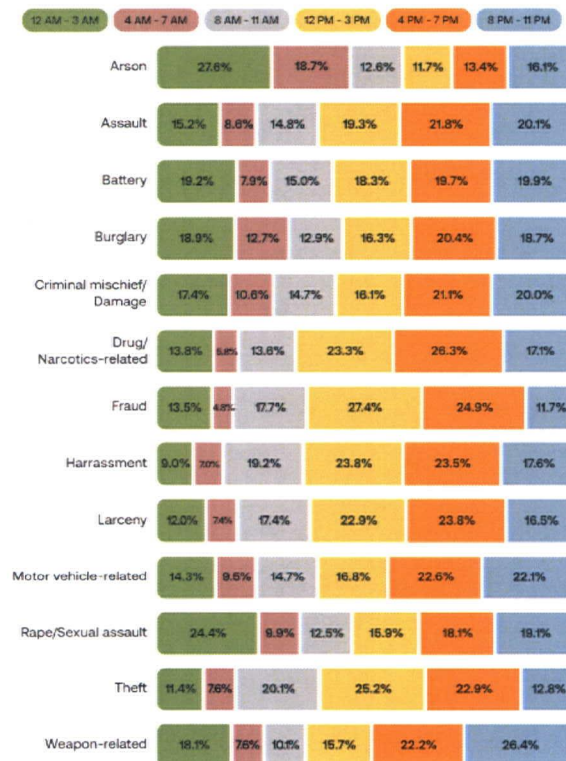

Surrounding Cities



Aurora, Colorado

- It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 18 years to loiter on or about any street, alley, sidewalk, parking lot, park, outdoor recreation or common area, or playground after the hour of 11:00 p.m. or prior to the hour of 5:00 a.m.

Boulder, Colorado

- In Boulder, minors under 16 are not allowed to be out anytime between 11 PM and 5 AM.

Denver, Colorado

- Minors under 18 are prohibited from being out between the hours of 11 PM and 5 AM on Sundays through Thursdays and between 12 midnight and 5 AM on Fridays and Saturdays.

Douglas County, Colorado

- The Douglas County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) approved a NEW 12am to 5am curfew every day of the week, year-round, for teenagers across unincorporated Douglas County and Larkspur.

Castle Rock, Colorado

- It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen (18) to loiter on or about any street, sidewalk, curb, gutter, parking lot, alley, vacant lot, park, playground or yard, whether public or private, without the consent or permission of the owner or occupant thereof, between the hours of midnight and 5:00 a.m. the following day.

Parker Curfew Laws

For the safety of our children, please be sure that your children are not out after midnight or before 5 a.m. any morning, unless they are accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, under lawful employment, with a person 18 or older and who has a written consent of parent or guardian in their possession or engaged in religious or civic activities.

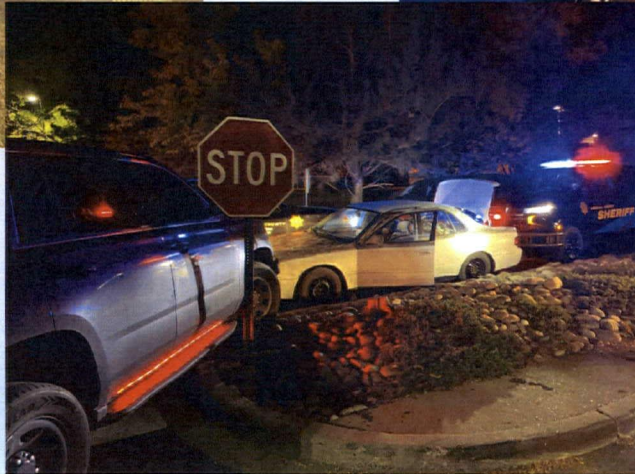
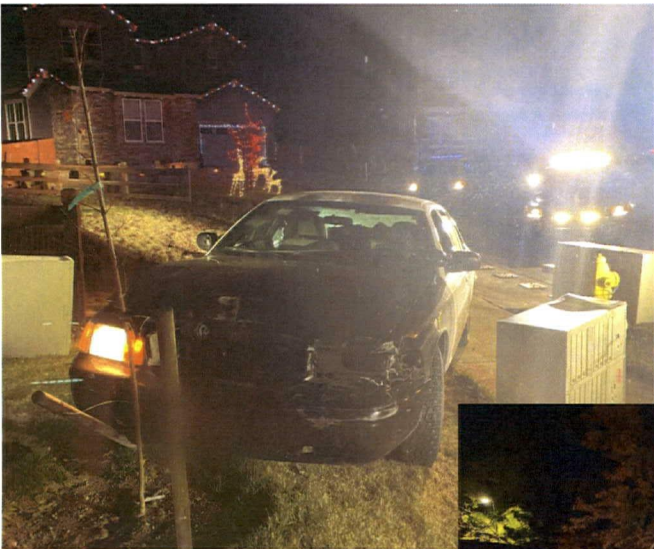
For the first year as a licensed driver, your teen must abide by a curfew - no driving between midnight and 5 a.m. unless accompanied by an instructor, parent, or legal guardian. Exceptions include driving to / from school / work (signed statement from school / work required), medical emergencies, and emancipated minors.

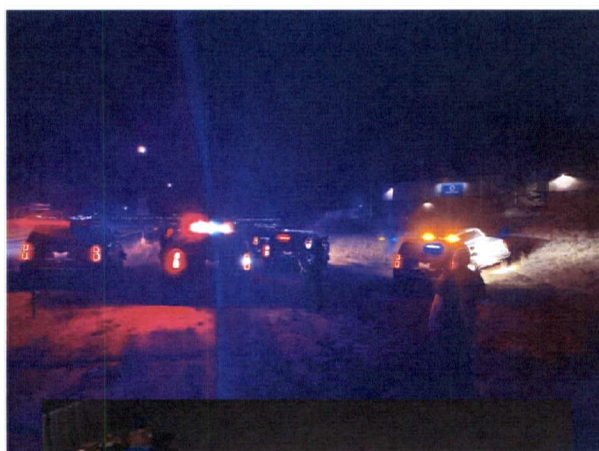
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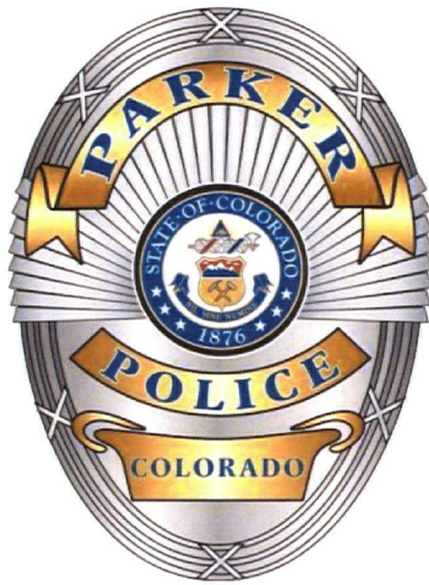

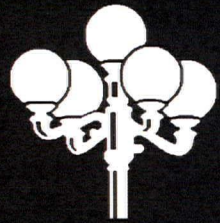
