CONTRACTS OVER \$500,000

Master Services and Purchasing Agreement for the Police Department Equipment and Fleet

Amount:	\$2,624,423.78
Contractor:	Axon Enterprises, Inc.
Department:	Police Department, Ken La Velle

Axon supplies the Police Department's body-worn cameras, tasers, in-car video cameras, and interview-room video cameras. The current Axon Program expires in July 2024. Once the current program ends, the Police Department will no longer have maintenance, support, or video storage for its current equipment. The new contract would cover five years of maintenance, support, and video storage on all program equipment. Approval of this contract before the end of 2023 locks in lower pricing for the next five years resulting in cost savings to the Town.

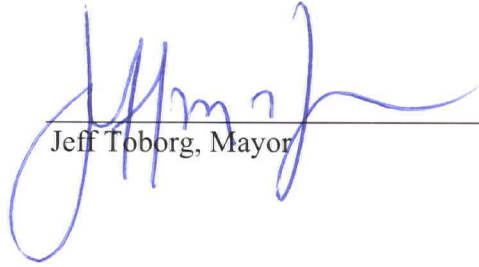
