OTHER BUSINESS**Art Gallery Liquor Permits**

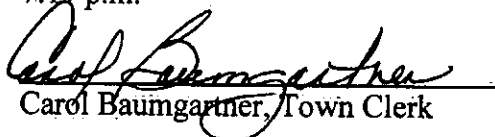

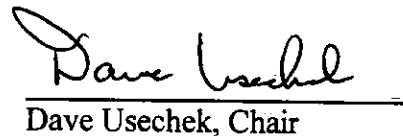
After a brief discussion regarding Art Gallery Liquor Permits, Mike Appleby moved to approve recommending to Council to add the Art Gallery Liquor Permit to the Town of Parker Code. David Lettkeman seconded the motion and was approved unanimously.

Attorney Corey Hoffman informed the Authority of the legislation that will be signed by the Governor that would eliminate 3.2% beer, age of server requirement, and distance requirement from schools, wine can be auctioned off under a Special Event Permit; and Title 12 will be moved to Title 44.

There will be a more in depth discussion at the July meeting.
