

**TOWN OF PARKER COUNCIL
MINUTES
JANUARY 13, 2025**

Mayor Joshua Rivero called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. All Councilmembers were present.

**DISCUSSION REGARDING THE APPOINTMENT OF A TOWN COUNCILMEMBER TO
FILL A VACANCY**

On December 16, 2024, Joshua Rivero resigned his position as Town Councilmember and was sworn in as the new Mayor for the Town of Parker. His term of office as a Councilmember would have ended in December 2026. Starting on December 17, the Town Council went through a public process to appoint an individual to fill the vacancy for Councilmember Rivero's remaining term. Between December 17 and December 23, the Town Council accepted applications from eligible persons interested in being considered for appointment to fill this vacancy. On December 27, a study session was held to review the submitted applications. On January 10, 2025, another study session was held to conduct interviews for those eligible individuals selected to move forward in the process to fill the vacancy.

Anne Barrington moved and Todd Hendreks seconded, pursuant to Section 2.9 of the Home Rule Charter of the Town of Parker, to appoint Erik Frandsen to the office of Councilmember for the Town of Parker, to fill the vacancy in this office created by the resignation of Joshua Rivero
