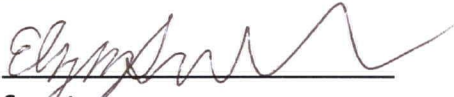
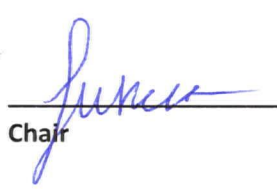

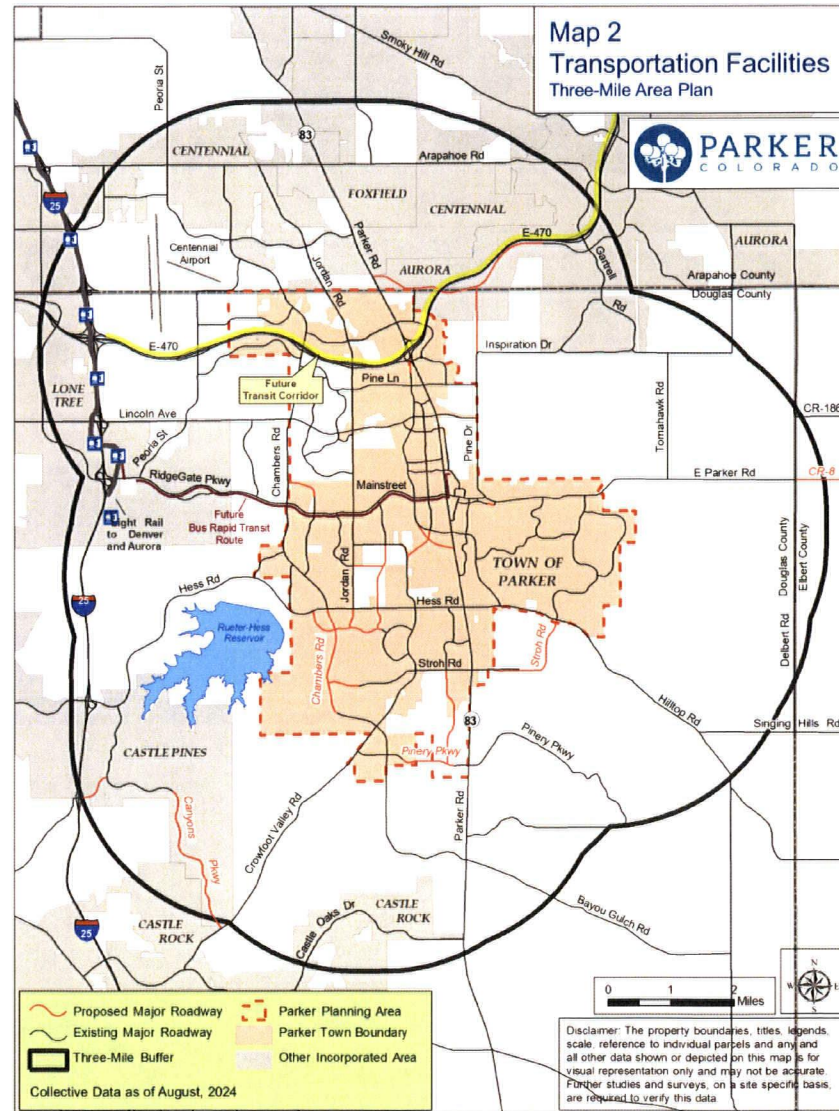

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Three Mile Plan Transportation Facilities

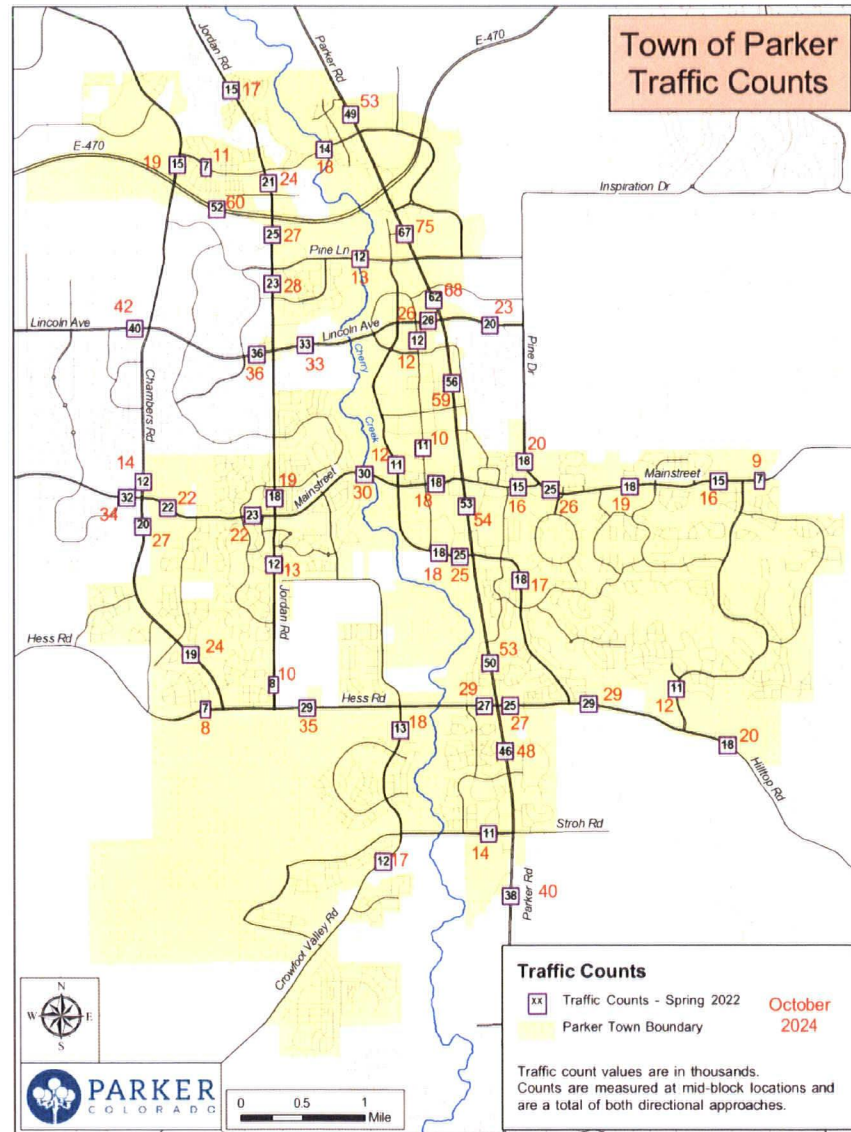


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Traffic Counts Spring 2022 & Fall 2024

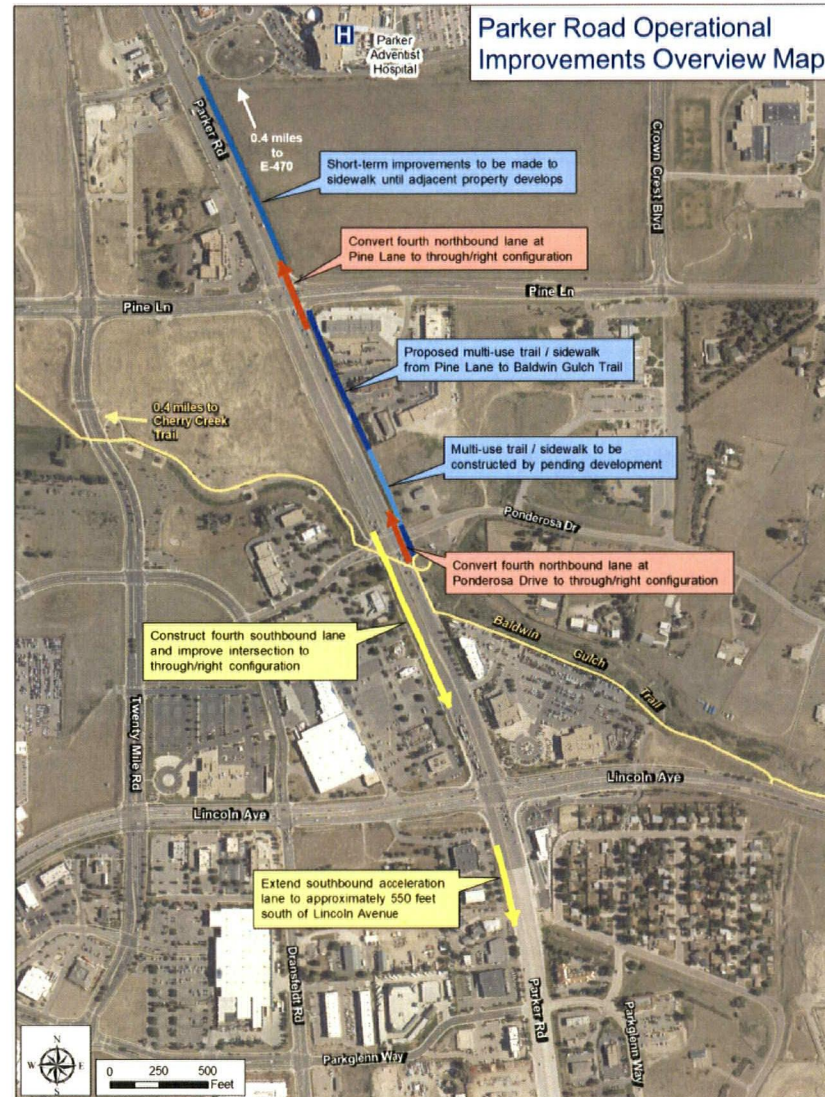


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Parker Road Operational Improvements

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Lincoln Avenue Widening to 6 Lanes Keystone Blvd to Parker Road

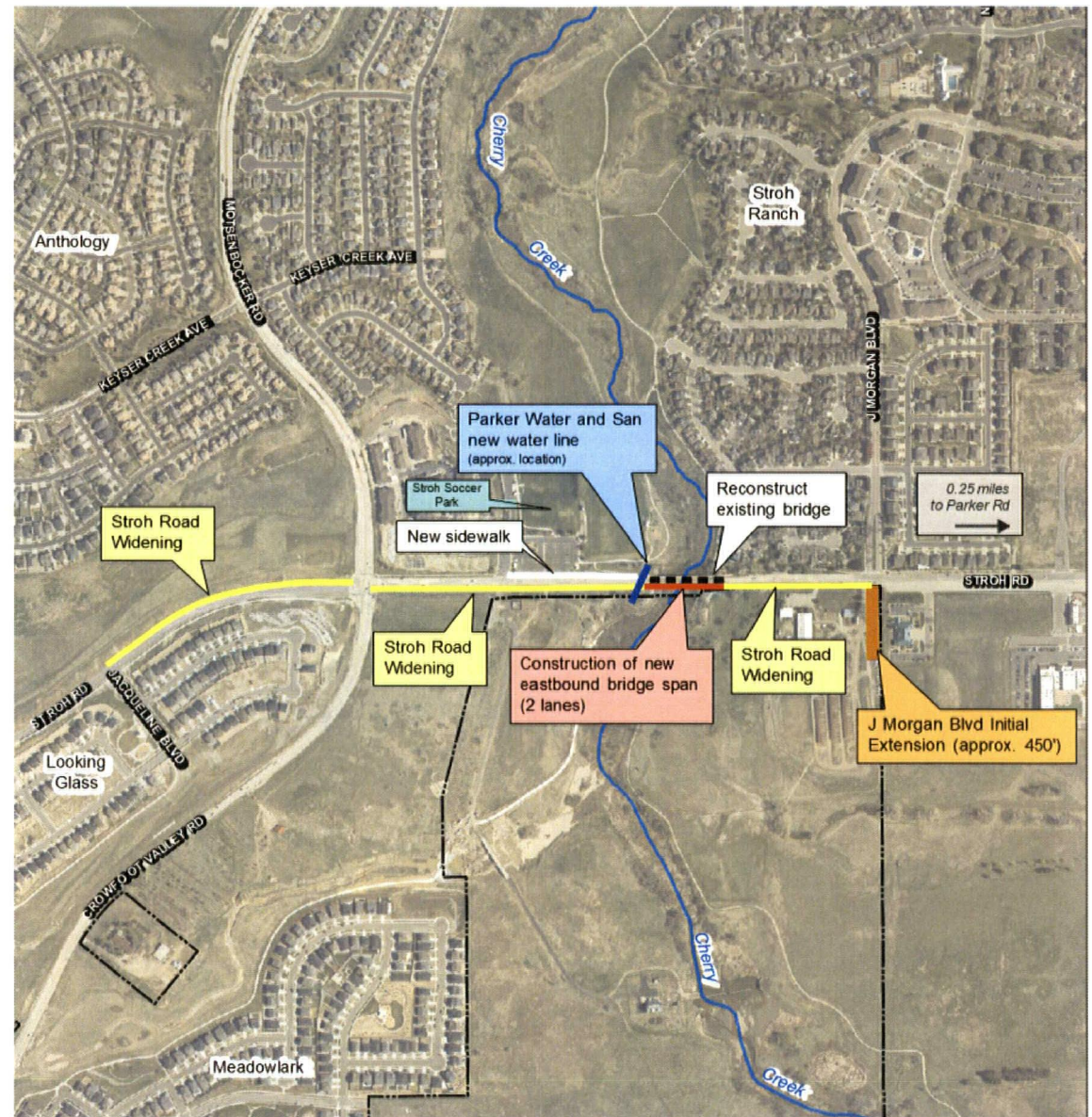


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Stroh Road Widening

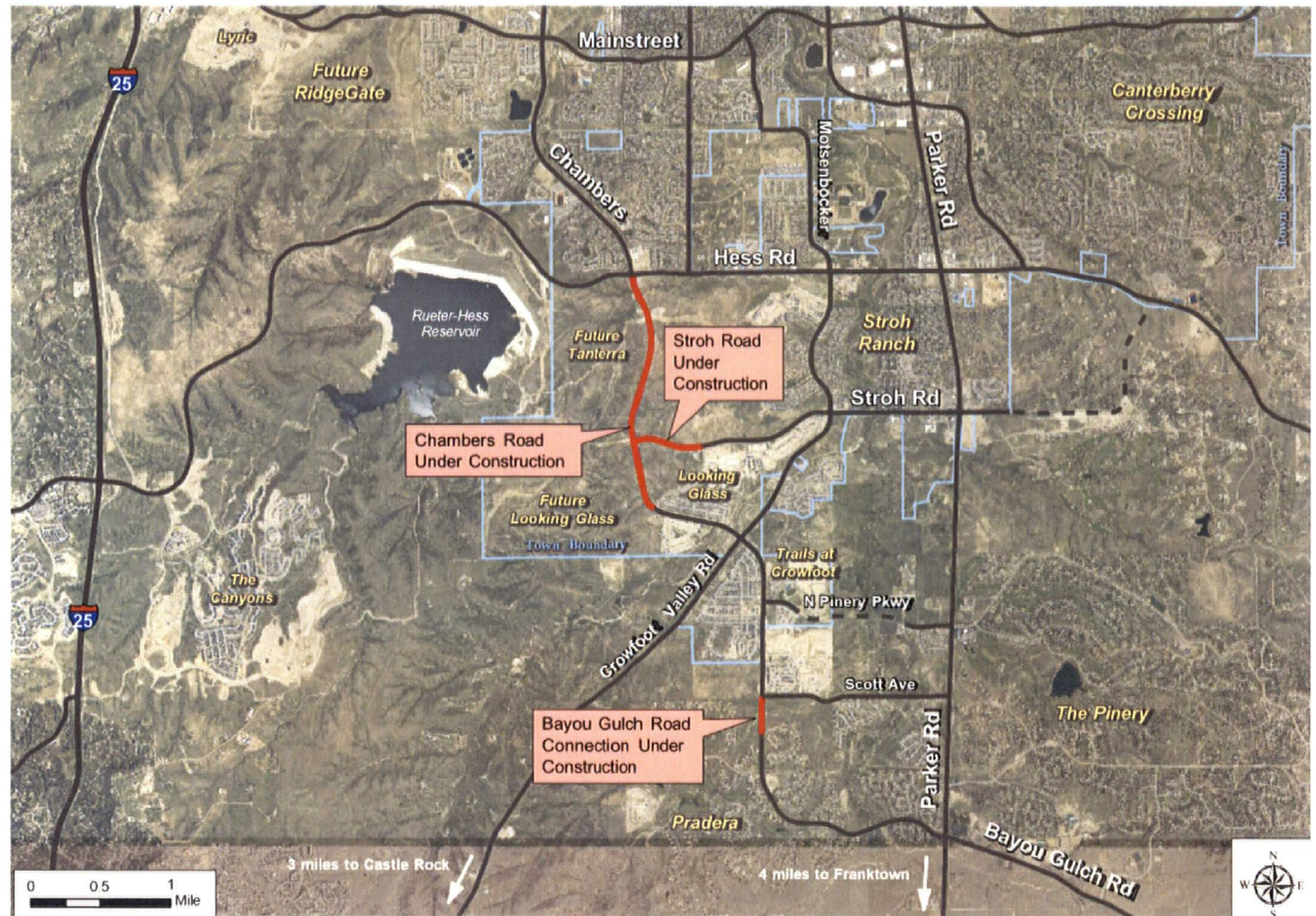


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Regional Roadway Connectivity

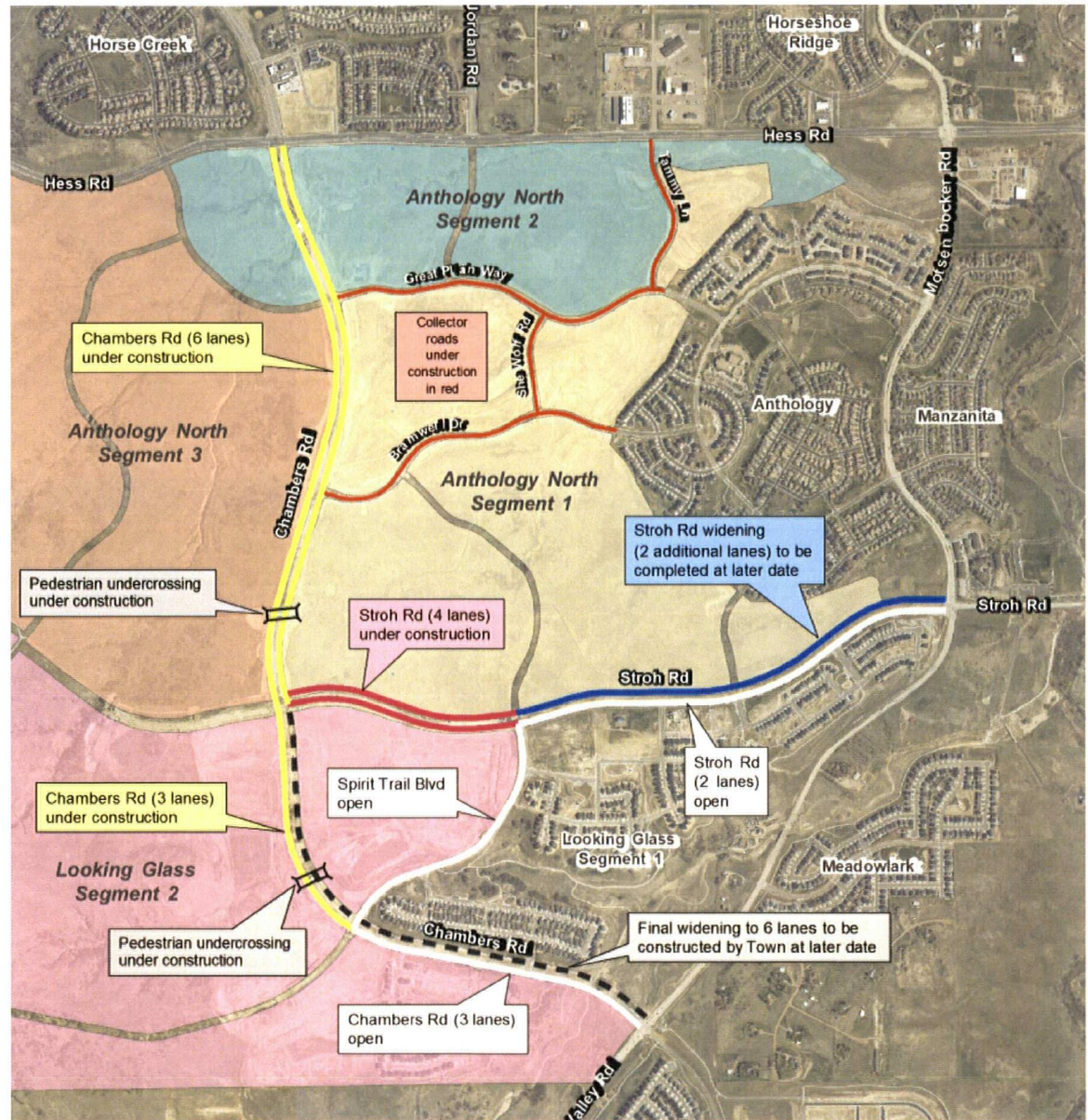


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Chambers Road and Stroh Road Arterial Completion Phases



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
