  - b. History Committee (Bethany) – Not doing Crime & Wine, shifting focus to building content for the website to go along with the parking garage mural, working with the consultant & Parker History on remodeling the Heritage Center at the Schoolhouse
  - c. Honey Festival Committee (Tom) - date set for August 2nd, vendors are lined up, 2 new committee members, the event is growing every year – 5,000 attendees last year
  - d. Science Committee
    - (Robert) Beginning planning for next Science Night, attendance capped at 2,000 due to space limitations, brainstorming alternatives to be able to increase registrations
    - (Allen) sponsored and presented two awards at Denver Metro Regional Science &

Engineering Fair:

- 'Culture & Science' prize awarded to Amy Zhang a high school senior for her project titled 'Just Look, Don't Type Enabling Intent Level Communications through Gaze Level Grounding & Disambiguation', it's a tool for those suffering from late-stage Lou Gehrig's disease to help them communicate. She invented a tool to look at an object and using AI to generate ideas & options for the person to communicate - rather than the traditional method of using their eyes by staring at letters long enough to type out letter by letter their words, which is very exhausting
  - 'Arts & Science' prize awarded to Evelyn ~~Seivers~~ <sup>Seivers</sup> for her project 'State of the Art; A Preemptive Look into Protecting Modern Art from Atmospheric Decay'. There's already a method to protect oil paintings but not acrylic paint. She partnered with Denver Art Museum to test degradation of acrylic paint to develop a method of protection.
- e. Strategic Planning Committee (Katie/Carrie) - plan adopted by town council, waiting for accessibility work to be completed and then it will go on the website and out to the public. Internal process for Phase I will be the focus for the first few years
